## INTRODUCTION

The Day 3 Masterclass, organised in collaboration between First Experts Sdn. Bhd. and Purple Door (M) Sdn. Bhd., turns the insights from PROTECT Sarawak 2026 into practical strategies, tools, and playbooks participants can immediately apply. Anchored in the conference themes of Sarawak's digital destiny, cybersecurity as an economic driver, and the Sarawak Digital Trust Blueprint, this intensive session combines expert guidance, hands-on simulations, and interactive labs. Participants will work through data governance exercises, insider threat tabletop drills, cyber risk deep dives, board-level governance discussions, and real-world case studies to strengthen cyber resilience and build stakeholder confidence across public and private sectors.

## » Programme Objectives

By the end of this Masterclass, participants will be able to:

- Connect the key messages from Day 1 and Day 2 keynotes and panels to their own organisational context, particularly around data protection, digital trust and strategic direction.
- Translate laws, regulations and policies (including PDPA and emerging global privacy frameworks) into concrete data governance controls, processes and behaviours.
- Design and apply a Cyber VAC-style digital trust scorecard that differentiates between technical cybersecurity KPIs and business-relevant trust metrics.
- Practise structured incident response through insider-threat tabletop simulations that emphasise trust preservation, stakeholder communication and accountability.
- Deepen their understanding of the evolving cyber threat landscape, including ransomware, zero-day exploitation and phishing-enabled espionage, and map these risks to their own environment.
- Strengthen board-level governance by framing cyber risk, resilience and incident response in a way that supports informed oversight, decision-making and potential director liability considerations.
- Explore how emerging technologies (AI, ML, IoT, blockchain and quantum) reshape the threat surface and how stealth-based cybersecurity and ZTNA approaches can mitigate these risks.

## » Target Participants

This Masterclass is designed for senior stakeholders responsible for cyber resilience, data protection and digital trust, including:

- Chief Information Security Officers (CISOs) and Heads of Cybersecurity.
- Data Protection Officers (DPOs), Chief Privacy Officers and compliance leaders.
- Board members, non-executive directors and senior executives responsible for risk and governance.
- Chief Risk Officers, Heads of Enterprise Risk, and Cyber Risk & Compliance Managers.
- CIOs, Heads of IT/ICT, and senior technology leaders supporting critical infrastructure and digital services.
- Business Continuity, Incident Response and Crisis Communications leads.

The content is particularly relevant for organisations in the public sector, government-linked companies (GLCs), financial services, utilities, healthcare, education and key economic sectors that are central to Sarawak's and Malaysia's digital trust agenda.

- Identify and prioritise key cyber risks (e.g., ransomware, zero-day exploits, phishing-enabled espionage) affecting their organisation, and align them with recognised cybersecurity frameworks and best practices.
- Outline the core elements of an effective board cyber governance framework, including technical "cyber balance sheet" reporting, incident response oversight and cyber-insurance considerations.
- Describe how stealth-based cybersecurity technologies and Zero Trust Network Access (ZTNA) approaches help reduce attack surface and support a more trusted digital ecosystem.
